_____ My child may participate in individual testing conducted by a Ball State University student. I understand that the results of such testing and reports thereof will be used only for the education and training of the Ball State students and will not become a part of my child's school records.

_____ I further understand that information about my child will not be released to any person or agency outside Ball State University without my permission.

_____ I understand that Burriss Laboratory School does not provide transportation for its students. I understand it is my responsibility to have my child arrive at school no earlier than 7:45 a.m. (*if eating breakfast student should arrive at 7:30 for breakfast*) and picked up no later than 5 minutes after the class is dismissed.
