College Early Admission Applications

Have you started applying for colleges? Many schools have an early admission deadline of **November 1st**.

Make sure you keep on top of deadlines for turning in forms and information for housing, financial aid, and scholarships in the coming months as you start receiving acceptance letters.

COLLEGE ADMISSION SESSIONS

Seniors, this is your chance to get inside information to help you stand out as you fill out applications for your favorite colleges. You can attend College Visit Days where college representatives come to Burriss/Indiana Academy and share about their school, and answer your questions. These College Visits usually last about 30 minutes, and you are excused from class.

To attend a college visit day:

1. Stop by the Burriss Counseling Center
2. Sign up on the clipboard for which college visits you want to attend
3. Ask the Counseling Center front desk worker for a College Visit Pass
4. Give the pass to your teacher at least a day ahead of time, and ask what work you will need to make up from your absence
5. Attend the College Visit – the visits are in Wagner Hall (the Indiana Academy building), which is between Burriss and the Student Center. Buzz in to their front office and ask for Mrs. Workman. She will walk you to the Sally Conference Center where the college visits will all take place.
6. Smile that you are one step closer to achieving your college dream
