Finals Study Tips

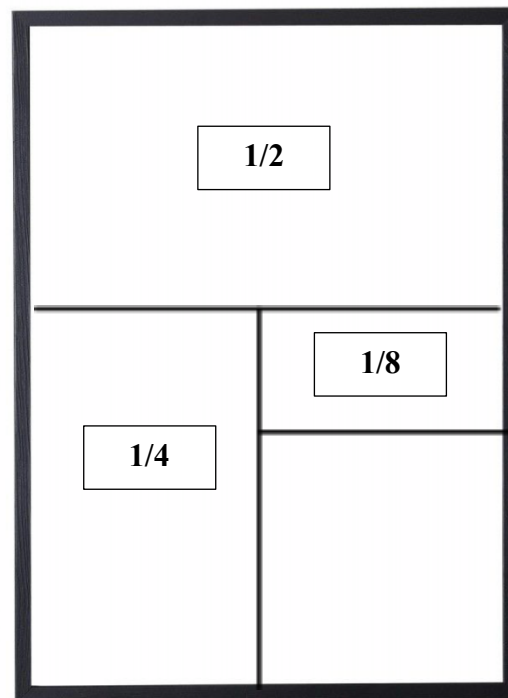

This scholarship grants full in-state tuition over four years, \$3,000 Professional Development Account to utilize for professional development, and ISU Laptop/iPad Award.
